**Reverend Robert J. Jasany
30th Anniversary**

Our Pastor, Father Robert Jasany, was ordained to the priesthood by Pope John Paul II over the tomb of St. Peter at St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City on June 24, 1979, which is the Solemnity of the Birth of John the Baptist. During his 30 years as a priest, his assignments have included serving as associate pastor at St. Charles Borromeo, St. Leo, Our Lady of Lourdes, St. Clement, and St. Rita. He has served as Spiritual Director of the Blue Army of Our Lady of Fatima, Cleveland District, for 22 years.

He came to us as Pastor in October 2000 when we were celebrating the 2,000th anniversary of the birth of Our Savior. During his time with us, we have celebrated our 100th anniversary as a parish, renovated the church interior and restored the artwork, installed air conditioning, a new sound system and a new organ, and became involved in the first group of parishes to institute a Stewardship initiative. He guided us through the Vibrant Parish Life process and oversaw the creation of a Finance Council to assist in parish operation. Several of our ministries have expanded and/or experienced successes such as our PSR program expanding to include a vacation bible school, our Guitar Choir receiving a grant to purchase items to enhance their ministry, and our Pastoral Council receiving a grant to create a garden on the corner of Fleet and Independence. Father has encouraged us to expand our ministries and to become more involved in the daily life of our parish.

We ask God to continue to bless Father Jasany and us as he continues to shepherd us at our parish. To celebrate Father's 30-year milestone, there will be a social after the 11 a.m. Mass on June 28 in the Social Hall. All are invited to attend to congratulate Father on his achievement.
