Stewardship Profiles

Building our Future with Living Stone

(These profiles are intended to spotlight the gifts of Time, Talent & Treasure that are evident in our parish.)

This week we are spotlighting a man who serves our Parish in a variety of ways. **Vince Radzilowski**, a parishioner since the early 1970s, is currently a member of Pastoral Council, a Parish School of Religion (PSR) teacher, a member of the Holy Name Society, and the treasurer of the Saint Vincent DePaul Society. He serves as an usher, is a long-time Parish picnic volunteer, and is one of several adult moderators for Youth Understanding Today's Experiences (Y.U.T.E.), our parish youth group. With all this involvement, he still finds time to be a husband to his wife, Christine, and a father to his children, Jonathan and Rachel. He works full time for the United States Postal Service, and he presented one of the Stewardship witness talks we heard last fall.

Vince attended Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) classes here and received the sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. As a teen and young adult, he was involved in the Awakening program -- weekend retreats designed to encourage teens to become more involved and informed about our faith (and with which many of our current parishioners were involved). He and Christine were married here in 1989, and both their children graduated from our school. "I believe the quality education they received at our school has helped transform them into the vibrant young adults they are today" Vince said.

Speaking of his involvement in PSR, Vince said, "I was hesitant at first, but I found that I enjoy the sharing, laughter and the learning that takes place in the classroom. I also enjoy watching the children growing and moving on to become fine adults." Vince said he enjoys all the ministries with which he is involved. "I am thankful to God for all the different people He has brought into my life. I have formed many new friendships through my ministries, and I look forward to meeting new people and working with them through our ministries in the future. It's an honor to serve God's people in our community," Vince said. May God bless Vince for all his dedication to our parish and our ministries.

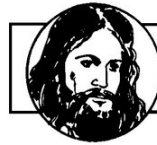
