Baptisms – The 2nd & 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism.

Weddings – Parishioners are to contact the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be **registered** and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. If you attend mass, but are not registered, please contact our parish office so that you can be registered here.

She said she would like the school to remain open because students benefit from the teaching and the guidance of the teachers and staff. "I would like to see the school continue for years to come. I would love to see new faces volunteer for the good of the school and the parish," she said.

Beth's three children – **Aaron, Matt** and **Emilee** – all attended school here and this year the Armbruster family celebrated a graduation triple-header: Emilee from 8th grade, Matt from St. Ignatius High School and Aaron from Xavier University. Beth is one of several adult moderators for Youth Understanding Today's Experiences (Y.U.T.E.), our parish youth group, along with her husband, **Jim**. Jim and Beth met as teens when they were members of a youth group. They described a youth group as a safe environment for teens, where they can share ideas and plans.

Beth helped obtain a grant to establish the Garden at St. John Nepomucene, and she participated in clearing the lot, spreading the soil, planting and watering the many plants, and continues to be involved in the Garden's maintenance. For 11 years, Beth served as the volunteer coordinator for the monthly Market Day fundraiser and was successful in involving other parents. She volunteers on Friday nights at Bingo, at the annual Parish Picnic, and has served on Pastoral Council. She is a Eucharistic Minister and said, "I enjoy sharing the body and blood of Jesus Christ with others."
