Rosary – Rosary is held at 8:00 AM on weekdays when morning Masses are celebrated.

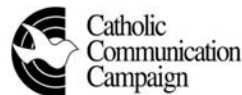
Baptisms – The 2nd & 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism.

Baptism Class- Before you baptize your child, parish and diocesan policy require you to complete a **Baptism Preparation Class**. The next class will be held on **October 4, 2009** at Holy Name Parish at 1:00 pm. Call 271-4242 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be **registered** and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. If you attend mass, but are not registered, please contact our parish office so that you can be registered here.

Pre -Cana Program for couples anticipating the Sacrament of Marriage will be held at the Jesuit Retreat House on **October 11th** at 12:45 pm. This program satisfies the requirement for marriage preparation as stipulated by the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland. Call 440-884-9300 to register.

Weddings – Parishioners are to contact the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (2002) tells us that "All other things being equal, Gregorian chant holds pride of place because it is proper to the Roman Liturgy....

"Since faithful from different countries come together ever more frequently, it is fitting that they know how to sing together at least some parts of the Ordinary of the Mass in Latin, especially the Creed and the Lord's Prayer, set to the simpler melodies" (GIRM §41).

Most recently, Pope Benedict in his Apostolic Exhortation *Sacramentum Caritatis*, said, "I desire ... that Gregorian chant be suitably esteemed and employed as the chant proper to the Roman liturgy" (§42).

Chanting is returning to our liturgies! By including even a few chants in each liturgy parish churches have found new sense of holiness not only through the text, but also in the melodies themselves.

If you are looking for music, which has continuity with the past and expresses holiness in text and melody then you will find Gregorian chant enriching in the context of liturgy.
